Full day trips are available from April to September, departing from Knightstone Harbour, Weston-super-Mare.

Book a trip, pack a picnic and join us for a day to remember on beautiful Steep Holm where there is something of interest for everyone.

See the large colonies of Lesser Black Back and Herring Gulls, the largest breeding colony of Cormorants in the Bristol Channel, wildflowers and rare plants - Steep Holm is home to the wild Mediterranean peony.

Explore the Victorian and WWII military installations. Follow the island trails or simply relax and enjoy the spectacular views of the English and Welsh coastlines.

The visitor centre is housed in the Victorian Barracks where you make your base for the day. Hot and cold drinks, home-made cakes and confectionery are available as well as a small licensed bar.

Souvenirs include island related books, clothing, and unique island stamps. There is a full postal service.
